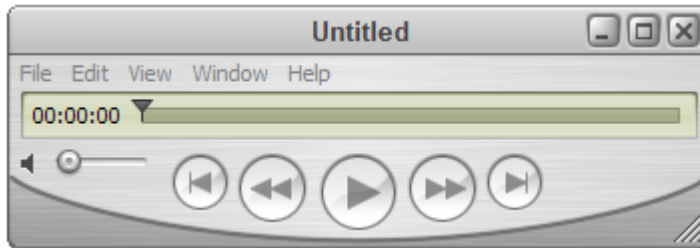


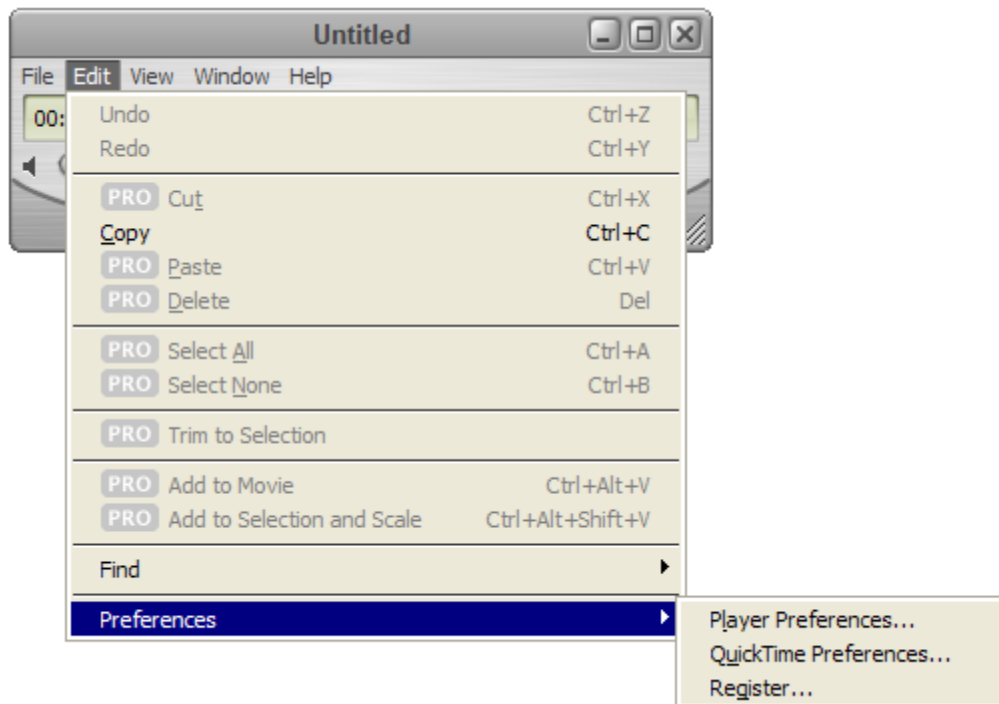
Disable *.TIF/*.TIFF files from opening through QuickTime

This procedure is used to disable *.tif/*.tiff files from opening up through Apples QuickTime when viewing them through a website. If you use QuickTime to display *.tif/*.tiff files through a web browser, QuickTime will only display and/or print the first page. Use the following steps to disable QuickTime from opening *.tif/*.tiff files which should default the Microsoft Office Document Imaging program as the viewer.

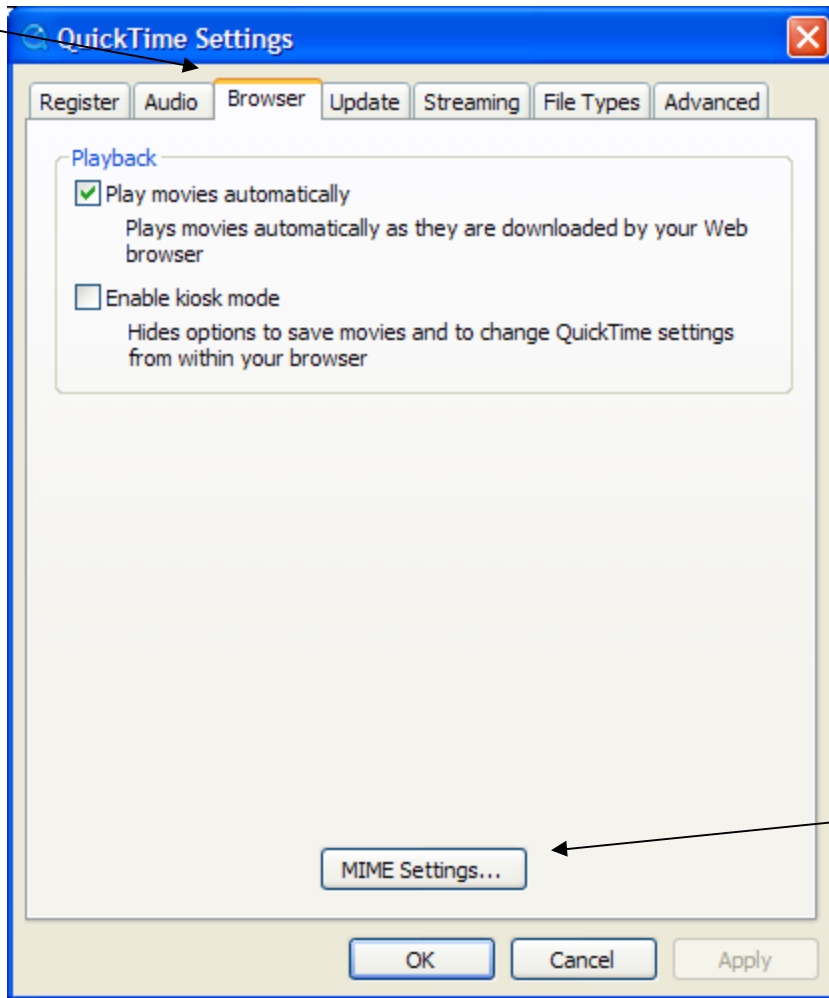
1. Open the QuickTime program.



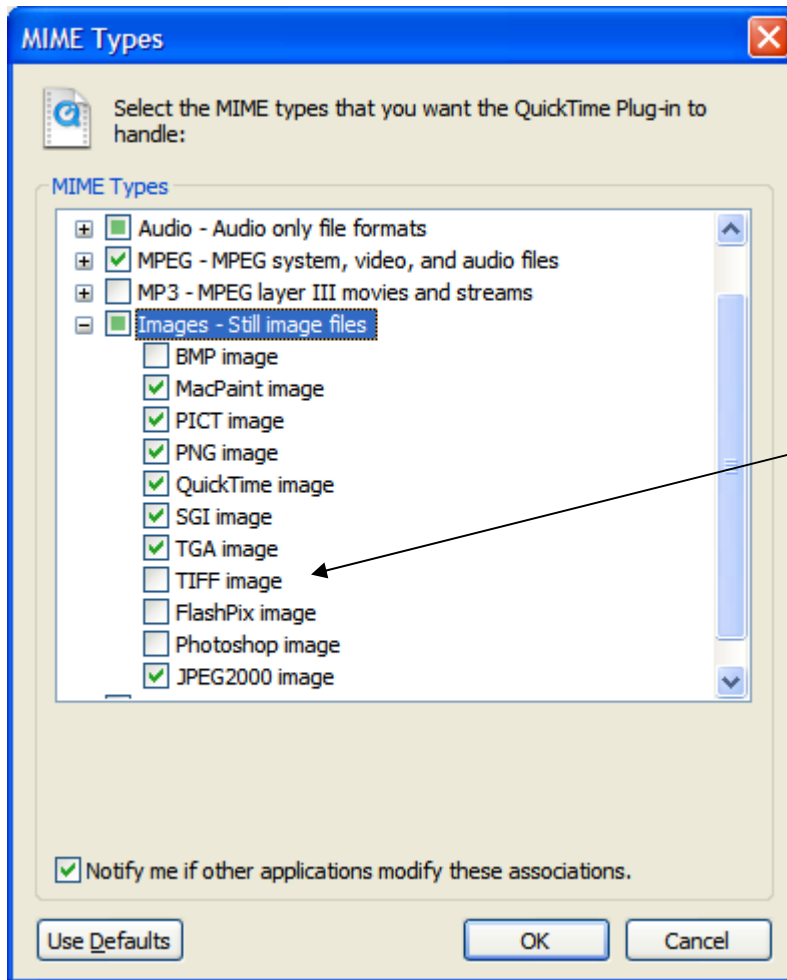
2. Click on **Edit>Preferences** then **QuickTime Preferences**.



3. Click on the **Browser** Tab and then the **MIME** settings button at the bottom of the page.

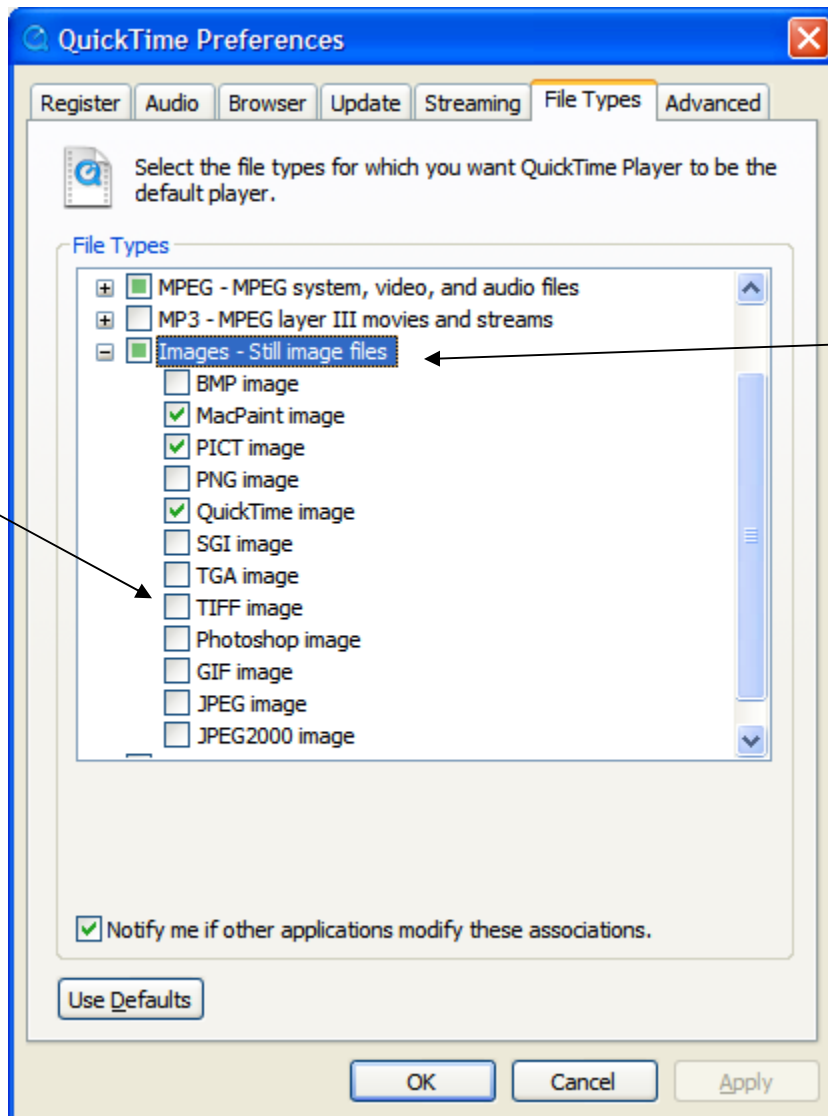


4. Click the plus sign besides “Images – Still images” to expand the selection and deselect the “TIFF image” box.



5. Click on **OK** at the bottom of the page.

- Click on the **File Types** tab and expand the Images –Still file images selection. Make the **Tiff image** box is unchecked.



- Click **OK** at the bottom of the page and **Apply** on the initial page. Click **OK** to exit the preferences.
- Close the QuickTime player.
- Close the browser and open the website again.

Be aware that the first time you open *.tif/*.tiff file after this change that it may take a moment to launch the new application. This should default the computer to the Microsoft Office Document Imaging program.
